Frasa-frasa yang berguna (Useful phrases)

Nanti bisa... - Later it can be..., or else...

This phrase is commonly used to state a possible consequence or outcome.

E.g. *Jangan ngebut, nanti bisa kecelakaan.*

Don't speed, you can have an accident.

Biar jadi... - so that (NP) become(s)...

This phrase is commonly used to state the intention of an action.

E.g. *Sering olahraga, biar jadi sehat.*

Exercise often, so that you get healthy.

Bikin masalah - making trouble

A 'trouble maker' is often called ***tukang bikin masalah***

Nggak boleh - Not allowed

Jangan lupa - Don't forget

Mending... dari pada ...(l) - It is better to... rather than...

E.g. *Mending belanja di pasar dari pada di mol, bisa nawar.*

It's better to shop at the market than the mall, you can bargain.

Sambil VP VP - VP while VP

This phrase is used in statements when doing two things at the same time.

E.g. *Sambil bikin PR denger musik.*

Listening to music while doing HW.

Jadi anak harus... - As a child one (/you) must/ought to be...

This phrase is said when expressing expectation.

E.g. *Jadi Muslim mesti sabar.*

As Muslims we need to be patient.
